Though this event is primarily for kayak fishermen we are opening it up to anyone using human powered means. This can include anything from a surfboard to a truck tire tube so long as it isn't motored by anything but your hard work the entire time.

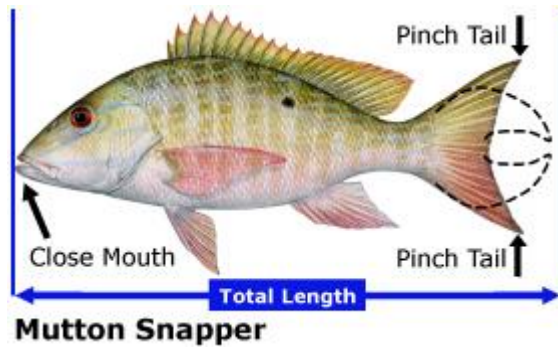
All kayaks/watercraft must be to New Brunswick regulation and fishing must be done according to the Department of Natural Resources laws.

Fees: 30\$ Entry fee for full weekend Tournament. This fee includes a year's subscription to Kayak Angler Magazine, a bag of swag, and first come first serve camping.

Children under 12 fish for free... All participants under 18 require parental consent liability waiver.

Rules and regulations for **General Tournament:**

1. Tournament fishing must be within the selected times 6:00am and 4:00pm. Fish caught outside this time will be disqualified.
2. Fishing must be done from a watercraft which is human powered the entire duration of the tournament. This watercraft must launch from the HRAA lodge property.
3. All fishing must comply with the Department of Natural Resource updated regulations. These can be found on their website <http://www.gnb.ca/0254/index-e.asp>
4. This tournament is a species tournament, which means the person who catches the widest variety of species wins. All fish are eligible for entry except for Atlantic Salmon. In the event of a tie, the total length of each participant's fish caught will determine the winner. Total length is the measurement from the tip of the snout to the tip of the tail (with the tail collapsed) in order to get the longest possible length measurement.



5. A clear, detailed color photo showing the full length side view of fish must accompany each entry. The fish should fill as much of the frame of the photograph as possible. Your picture should include the approved and numbered measurement device alongside the fish to verify length. Both the fish and ruler should be the same distance from the camera. The photos must be clear enough to easily tell the length of the fish. Judges have the authority to make each call on a case to case basis.
6. Cameras must be handed to the judges by 4:10pm to qualify photos.
7. If there is any question about a fish having any relation to a motorboat it will be disqualified, as will your team from the tournament. Further actions will result in banning from future events.
8. Loitering around motorboats will be cause for disqualification. We aren't out to prevent you from having fun with friends but we feel that when the tournament is taking place it is necessary for participants to be clear from other motorboats in order to prevent speculation about fish passing.

Directions to the Hammond River Angling Association Lodge:

If coming via Saint John, while driving through Rothesay on the MacKay Highway look for the Nauwigewauk exit and take it. Drive approximately 3 Km until you come to an RV dealership on the left and a Polish restaurant on the right. Cross the bridge, and take the first right. Drive approximately 300 metres and the lodge will be on the right.

If coming via Sussex, drive until you get to Hampton and take that exit. At the stop, turn right, drive about 50 metres and then take the first left. Drive for about ten minutes then once you pass by an Ultramar, keep driving up two hills, then on the bottom of the 2nd hill you will see a bridge. Take the left right before the bridge, drive approximately 300 m and the lodge will be on the right.

Lodging

The HRAA grounds and adjacent farmland have ample space for camping on a first come first serve basis. If camping is not your thing, there is the Hampton Inn in Quispamsis (about ten minutes south) or multiple hotels and motels just a little further in Saint John.
